

## Itinerary for Sangha Japan Trip July 9–24, 2001

11 <sup>th</sup> Wednesday	Walk	<b>Nanzen-ji</b> plus big walking day, get to know area. Philosophers walk, beginning with <b>Nanzen-ji</b> , and sub temples, each with a temple fee: <b>Nanzen-in</b> , <b>Tenjuan</b> , <b>Konchi-in</b> . Then Eikan-do, <b>Zenrin-ji</b> , <b>Honen-in</b> , ending with ( <b>Ginkaku-ji</b> ) or the ( <b>Kyoto Handcraft Center</b> ) and then a long walk home on the philosopher's walk or through all the shops in Gion district.
12 <sup>th</sup> Thursday	Tour Bus	<b>Ryoan-ji</b> . Lunch at Ryoanji then by bus to, <b>Daisen-in</b> and <b>Daitokuji</b> , <b>Myoshinji</b> .
13 <sup>th</sup> Friday	Tour Bus	<b>Koryu-ji</b> , then <b>Tenryu-ji (Kozanji, Jingoji)</b> or <b>Katsura Rikyu</b> (if we are able to go as a group).
14 <sup>th</sup> Saturday	Walk	<b>Sanjusangendo</b> , <b>National Museum</b> , ( <b>Kyoto Craft Center</b> , gardens at <b>Chishakuin</b> see two famous Edo paintings: Cherry tree, sakura-zu and maple tree, Kaede-zu) and <b>Shorenin</b> , then <b>Kenninji</b> and its gardens. 2-3 miles all around. Also if time, <b>Kawai Kanjiro Memorial Hall</b> exhibit of famous 20th century potter. Anyone who wants to can walk to <b>Kyomizudera</b> on the way home. Lots of shops and restaurants.
15 <sup>th</sup> Sunday	Tour Bus	<b>Nara</b> : Bus to take us to several different areas, <b>Horyu-ji</b> and <b>Chugu-in</b> . Then <b>Toshodai-ji</b> , <b>Yakushi-ji</b> , ( <b>Hokkeji</b> , <b>Saidaiji</b> ).
16 <sup>th</sup> Monday	Tour Bus	<b>Nara</b> : Long day, much walking. Bus to drop us at one place and pick us up there at end of afternoon. <b>Kofuku-ji</b> , <b>Nara Museum</b> , other museum, <b>Todaiji</b> , <b>Daibutsuden</b> , <b>Shoso-in</b> (and, if time, <b>Shinyakudaiji</b> ).
17 <sup>th</sup> Tuesday		<b>FREE DAY</b>
18 <sup>th</sup> Wednesday	JR Pass	<b>Obama (Bukkokuji, Tange Roshi)</b> . Long day, leave early return on Thursday, the 19 <sup>th</sup> .
20 <sup>th</sup> Friday	Tour Bus	<b>Sanzen-in</b> and <b>Enryakuji</b> . Long day. Sanzen-in: early so there is enough time to get lunch and stop at Enryaku-ji (Tendai) at Mt Hiei. <b>Shukakuji</b> (or Shugakuin) is less crowded and has lovely gardens. Will be a tight schedule, big day, we should leave early.
21 <sup>st</sup> Saturday	Bus?	<b>OPTIONAL FREE DAY</b> or <b>Toji Temple antique fair</b> . Next ( <b>Kosho-ji</b> and <b>Sosen-ji</b> ). Walk to <b>Tofuku-ji</b> or <b>Sennyuji</b> , <b>Imakumano-kannonji</b> and the gardens at <b>Chishaku-in</b> . Big walking day.
22 <sup>nd</sup> Sunday	JR Pass	<b>Kamakura</b> . Long day.
23 <sup>rd</sup> Monday	Tour Bus	Several different stops with bus. <b>Byodoin</b> and <b>Mampuku-ji</b> . <b>Daigoji</b> and gardens at <b>Kanjuji</b> . This will not be as long a trip as the two days in Nara. It should be an easier day.
24 <sup>th</sup> Tuesday	JR Pass	<b>To Osaka and Canada</b> .
